Executive Director and Committee Reports

Committees

- CEC—potential new committee members from Skagit County and SITC. Promoting school programs with teachers. Committee assessing online, searchable list of programs. Hannah Liss from PSP brought a list of resources as well.
- Protection Subcommittee is working on two properties with restoration needs that will probably be first test cases for new policy on Approval Process for Acquiring Restorable Lands. No greenlights since last meeting.
- M&AM Subcommittee had a short meeting. Began a discussion of how to prioritize pocket estuaries in Whidbey Basin. Discussed using project/focus metrics from PRISM to do some watershed-wide accounting of progress. Discussed timing of Skagit Chinook Recovery Plan update (not until after FERC relicensing). Co-manager are leads on this.

- Riparian Work Group did not meet. SWC signed an expansion of our contract with SRSC for working on this task, including riparian database, conference, and listserv.

Rose Foundation Grant—Rose has \$1million to fund water quality and outreach in the Skagit, settlement funds from a Clean Water Act violation.
