Beginning Business

WDFW Presentation on warm water fish predation of salmon study

WDFW proposes to study warm water (non-native) fish predation of smolts in Big Lake and WRIA 10 lakes to evaluate the effectiveness of current fishing regulations on minimizing predation of salmon.

- ➤ Liberalized harvest regulations have probably resulted in smaller warm water fish which tend to eat more smolts than larger fish, driving up predation of smolts. They plan to study this.
- ➤ Goal is to 'fine tune' regulations to improve smolt production.
- > Eradication of warm water fish is on the table as outcome.
- > Seeking \$50,000 from Skagit lead entity and support at regional level to compete for monitoring funds.
- > Jessica is point person.

2022 Monitoring Project/s

- The warm water fish study is not eligible for Skagit monitoring funds because it does not meet the criteria in the Program Guide. Aundrea will write a letter to Jessica.
- ➤ The committee will review the 4 YWP and other potential projects and bring proposals to the table at next meeting.
- The committee reaffirms that a nondiscretionary set aside is recommended for the RFP because monitoring is a fundamental component of any capital program. This will be relayed to the Board.

Pocket Estuary Map to accompany changes to Strategic Approach

Mike reviewed the salmon data and advises the map include Bowman Bay (same as drafted by the TWG). All agree.
